Academic Review Day: 20th November 2023

We are pleased to update you on the organisation of our parent meetings. This will be like an INSET day so the school is closed to pupils on that day. This will run from 10.00am-4.30pm. You will be able to book appointments in the same way as previously. We will send communication out about this in a separate correspondence.

You will then come to school during your appointment time with your child/family to talk through your child's progress and attendance with their teacher.

For pupils who have an individual support plan, parents will also be able to review ISPs during the day. Support staff will be available in the KS2 hall 10.00am-3.30pm to do this with you.

Following this, we will send out a questionnaire to ascertain parental feedback for future planning.

Dojo Communication/Phase Out Class Emails: Years 1 to 6

We are really pleased to be using Class Dojo as a messaging system. We are phasing out the class email system in Years 1 to 6. If you are not already signed up, please contact the school office or your child's class teacher. By using our school Dojo site, you agree to the terms set out in our home partnership agreement and parental code of conduct.





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Parents may message class teachers at any time, however there is no expectation for teachers to reply outside the hours of 8.30am-3.30pm. This is essential to safeguard the wellbeing and work-life balance of our staff.

The following matters should always go through to our Main Office and are not the responsibility of teachers to be passed on: absence, sickness, school dinner enquiries and complaints.

Teachers will not be able to get into a long conversation on Dojo. If you require further details regarding a concern/issue please make an appointment to have a phone call or face to face meeting. Parents who do not use the messaging system correctly and respectfully will be treated in line with the parental code of conduct.
