# Safe Entry and Exit into And Out of School

Thank you for your feedback about the entry into school and gate opening. Just to clarify, the gates are opened at 8.35am in the morning. Please supervise your child/children on the playground whilst they are waiting for the bell to go. Only children in Upper Key Stage Two and only if parents feel confident that they can safely get themselves to school, should be arriving by themselves.

All children up to Year 4 should be supervised by a parent/adult at all times when journeying to and from school.

Please can we remind all families to use the crossings marked inside the school when crossing the driveway that leads to the main gates, especially at the end of the day when it is busier with cars. If you have permission to drive into school, such as a blue badge holder, please also be mindful that you may have to wait during the very busy times (usually 3.10-3.20pm when the majority of pupils are walking out.

### **Concerns Over Huggy Wuggy**

It has again come to our attention that some children are talking about the character Huggy Wuggy and causing upset and worry. Huggy Wuggy can be accessed in a variety of places. Some children have played Playtime Poppy despite its 12+ rating by Common Sense Media. Other children have seen videos of the monster-bear hybrid on YouTube and TikTok, and some simply know of Huggy Wuggy based on the toy, which is sold in gift shops across the country and is regularly given out as a carnival prize. It has been said some children are even replicating Huggy Wuggy on the playground, playing it as they would tag or another like game. The school is not made aware of who has consented or not, therefore please direct any queries to the Immunisation team directly.





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
## Academic Review Day: 20th November 2023

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# Parenting Support for Children Who Suffer with Sleep Issues

Please see the link <u>here</u> for helping parents and children to learn more about their sleep and develop better bedtime routines. Sleep is essential to brain function. By helping children to sleep better, we can help them to succeed in school.

At any given time up to 40% of adults and 50% of children (this rises to 80% with a SEND diagnosis) have difficulties with their sleep. Yet in a recent survey, almost 60% of adults felt there was a lack of support for sleep issues. Sleep problems can leave people feeling isolated and lonely.

Our free helpline is run by trained sleep advisors, many of whom are specialists in working with SEND. We can talk to young people directly, or parents (we can also talk to adults, including older people, about their sleep issues).

The helpline is open 5 times a week, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday evenings 7-9pm, and Monday, Wednesday mornings 9-11am. The number is 03303 530 541.
