## Unique Voice - Y5/6 Belonging in the Community Workshop

On Wednesday 13th March Y5/6 pupils will be taking part in a violence reduction workshop. The programme is centred around an empathetic approach to begin an early and age-appropriate understanding of exploitation and serious youth violence for young people attending primary schools in South Gloucestershire. The delivery of the programme, to be held on school site, consists of a 30-minute assembly and a workshop to follow up and explore the topic with the young people. The aims are:

- Let's learn how we forge lasting trust within young people and ensure they foster a sense of belonging in their community.
- Let's build on lifting up our young people so they feel valued, seen and heard.
- Let's create communities that have a deep sense of connection, understanding, network and belonging.
