Use the suggested resources to find this information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A map of the capital cities of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland • Four seaside resorts • Four countryside areas • Four cultural or historical towns • Six major gateway airports (to resorts overseas) with their 3 letter code

On the additional map provided identify a passenger route from each including UK to Republic of Ireland and UK to a European destination. • Three motorways, including the destinations connected by them • Three rail lines, including the destinations connected by each line. <p>Evidence Required: Eight maps with each destination, gateway and route accurately located.</p> <p>Task 2:</p> <p>You are now required to plan three separate routes. For each you should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Departure point • Destination • Mode of transport • Timings of travel – how long will it take? <p>You should plan</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One route using road travel • One route using rail travel • One route using air travel
